Dr. Scott McCormick (a.k.a. "Doc" to his students) received his D.M.A. from Indiana University Bloomington in Music Performance and Literature (Viola). He is in his 20th year of teaching at Langley High School. He was more recently invited to join the music faculty at Patrick Henry College, where he teaches Chamber music, pedagogy, and music theory. He is also a core member of the Washington Bach Consort, the area's premiere baroque orchestra and chorus. Doc is honored to have received Langley's Outstanding Teacher of the Year Award in 2018.

Doc lives on a small acreage in Loudoun County with his wife Rebekah and their

children, Norah and Hugh. The property is also home to 16 heritage breed chickens, a chocolate lab, a Siamese cat, and a family of hummingbirds.



How did the students create a virtual performance??

- 1. <u>Create a backing track</u>. Each track included instructions to clap (see steps 4 and 5) and a recording of Alyssa Kim (violin), Fay Shuai (cello), or Doc (viola) playing the piece.
- 2. <u>Record and collect submissions</u>. Each orchestra student used the backing track to record him- or herself playing the piece, and then submitted the recording to Riker.
- 3. <u>Convert the files</u>. Riker converted each audio file to the uncompressed audio format .WAV to retain its maximum quality.
- 4. <u>Mix the audio</u>. Riker lined up all the claps, balanced the audio by adjusting the volume of each individual clip, and then merged the clips by section.
- 5. <u>Create the video</u>. This was the most difficult and time-consuming step. Each video editor lined up the videos by lining up the claps, then used the transform and crop tools A LOT to shape the video. Each editor had creative freedom to highlight certain musicians, cut to a shot of just the soloist, or include a shot of all musicians on screen at one time.
