



Rotary Club of Great Falls Music Contest 2021

Objective: To help promising musicians gain notice in their communities and introduce high school students to the “Service Above Self” mission of Rotary.

Applicants: Musicians (vocal, keyboard and instrumental) from Langley High School are invited to submit solo performances via video.

Awards:

- Rotary Club of Great Falls: First Place (\$300), Second Place (\$200) and Third Place (\$100).
- The Club’s First Place presentation will be submitted to the Rotary District Level competition which will award First Place (\$1,000), Second Place (\$500) and Third Place (\$250).

Rules:

- Each participant must submit the completed Entry Form (link below), including signed parental release.
- Applicants should provide their video music presentations via a link to a private YouTube site.
- Applicants should introduce themselves on their prepared video as well as announce the title and composer of the work. Introductions should last no longer than 30 seconds.
- Performances should not exceed 5 minutes.
- No political commentary or offensive language is permitted.

Judging: Evaluation will be based on factors such as level of difficulty, execution, expression, creativity, and poise.
