Anyway, I want to thank you all for joining me in this journey and to wish you all the best on your next adventures. I hope that you will always look back fondly on your time with the orchestra. I hope you will find that music is a powerful catalyst that will lead you to positive connections. It is also my sincere hope that many of you will return to our stage at Langley someday (maybe next year's Spring concert) to be honored with the usual graduation traditions that you earned. I believe the world could use unifying, live events like orchestra performances more than ever now -- and that music will endure.
