# Dr. Scott McCormick

## Langley Orchestra Director

Dr. Scott McCormick (a.k.a. "Doc" to his students) received his D.M.A. from Indiana University Bloomington in Music Performance and Literature (Viola). He is in his 22nd year of teaching at Langley High School and is honored to have received Langley's Outstanding Teacher of the Year Award in 2018. He is also an Adjunct Professor at Patrick Henry College in Purcellville where he directs the Chamber orchestra, Harp Ensemble and teaches Applied Strings. He is also a core member of the Washington Bach Consort, the area's premiere Baroque orchestra and chorus.



Doc lives on a small rural property in Western Loudoun County with his wife, Rebekah, and their children, Norah and Hugh, (affectionately known as the Doclings). Other residents of Doc's homestead include a Chocolate Lab, a Siamese cat, a family of hummingbirds, and an award-winning flock of heritage breed chickens. His hens have won the Grand Champion prize at the Loudoun County Fair Poultry Show for the past two years: the most recent winner, a Wheaten Maran pullet named Lupine, performs a variety of tricks -- including playing the xylophone.

# Ms. Elizabeth Leung

## Cooper Orchestra Director

Ms. Elizabeth Leung is in her ninth year of teaching at Cooper Middle School. Ms. Leung earned her B.M.E. from Indiana University and M.M. in violin performance from George Mason University. She was the concertmaster of the George Mason Symphony Orchestra for two years, and her principal teachers were Brenda Brenner (IU) and June Huang (GMU). Ms. Leung is the strings rehearsal coach for Young Artists of America at Strathmore and Maryland Classic Youth Orchestras at Strathmore (MCYO), and a violin and viola sectional coach for the American Youth Philharmonic Orchestras (AYSE and AYDO). She works with the MCYO Philharmonic orchestra and is the assistant conductor for the Kamerata group. Outside of music, Ms. Leung searches for the perfect soup dumpling, hikes, power-lifts, cross-fits, rock climbs, and cares for her two pit-bull rescues, Diesel and Brie, with her husband, Vadim.
