

Langley Orchestra: NYC Trip Packing List

Per FCPS policy, no student on this trip, regardless of age or maturity level, is permitted to self-carry or self-administer any over-the-counter (OTC) or prescribed medication. The only exception to this is for students who have properly submitted medical authorizations (one per medication, filled out and signed by a licensed prescriber) for the self-carry of prescription Epi-pens or asthma inhalers.

- ___ Photo ID--REQUIRED (Langley ID, driver's license or permit)
- ___ A wallet to carry cash, ID, room key
- ___ \$100 **cash** for daily lunches and snacks in the city and on the ride home, plus extra spending money of your own choosing. NO CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS. CASH ONLY.
- ___ Instrument, bow, rosin, case, and rock stop (if required), labeled with nametag
- ___ Disposable Bag Lunch for Trip Up to New York
- ___ Snacks for the bus trip
- ___ Water bottle and a few compact, filling snacks for in NYC. (No "hangries", please.)
- ___ Complimentary Langley Orchestra labeled drawstring bag to carry water bottle, compact snacks, gloves, hat, compact umbrella/raincoat, phone chargers, hand sanitizer, and other small items—things that wouldn't matter much if they got lost
- ___ A compact cross shoulder to carry valuables (wallet, phone)
- ___ Orchestra formal wear packed into your complimentary labeled Langley Orchestra garment bag (Full tux with bowtie and cummerbund or gown including all-black, closed-toe dress shoes, and black socks for tuxedos. (Put shoes inside in a small plastic bag.)
- ___ Change of clothes for four days and sleepwear
- ___ Warm coat, gloves, hat, scarf depending on weather
- ___ Poncho, light raincoat, or compact umbrella
- ___ Comfortable walking shoes and warm socks
- ___ Phone w/ headphones for room & bus, both an in-wall and a portable phone charger, and headphones for room & bus
- ___ Toiletries including toothbrush/toothpaste/soap/shampoo/deodorant, etc.
- ___ Extra contact lenses and/or eyeglasses, if needed

Make your bags easily stand out from the rest!

Tie the same ribbons or piece of fabric to the handles/straps of each.
