


Dr. Scott McCormick

Dr. Scott McCormick (a.k.a "Doc" to his students) received his D.M.A. from Indiana University Bloomington in Music Performance and Literature (Viola). He is in his 24th year of teaching at Langley High School and is honored to have received Langley's Outstanding Teacher of the Year Award in 2018.

District XII Orchestra Assessments

Each year, the Virginia Band & Orchestra Directors Association (VBODA) organizes assessment opportunities for all of the instrumental music programs in the state. A panel of professional adjudicators is assembled for each of the 16 districts to evaluate participating ensembles and assign scores according to state standards of excellence. The factors considered include: tone production, technique, balance, intonation, ensemble, musicianship, sight-reading, and professionalism. Our district (No. 12) is known to be one of the largest and most advanced demonstrations of secondary orchestral music in the entire nation.

All students in the Langley Philharmonic and Symphonic orchestras (Junior & Senior sections) are required to attend (and arrange their own transportation) to this competition to represent our school. Parents, family, and friends are strongly encouraged to come cheer them on - it can make a big difference to the judges when the groups reflect the energy of their supporters.
