


Dr. Scott McCormick

Dr. Scott McCormick (a.k.a "Doc" to his students) received his D.M.A. from Indiana University Bloomington in Music Performance and Literature (Viola). He is in his 25th year of teaching at Langley High School and is honored to have received Langley's Outstanding Teacher of the Year Award in 2018.


